#### **Program Description**

Selected students will participate in the clinical activities of the chosen department including conferences and other educational activities. Students will receive up to \$950 for housing during their elective which may be accompanied by a stipend provided by the individual department to which the student is assigned. \* Electives are available from August through March.

#### Eligibility

Students must be enrolled as a 4<sup>th</sup> year student in an LCME or COCA accredited institution at the time of the elective.

Students who are members of groups underrepresented in medicine are encouraged to apply.

#### **Application Process**
