


Title: Graduate Medical Education - Reporting of Other Learners in a Program - Policy

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I. Policy Statement

- a. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that resident education is not compromised by the presence of learners other than the current residents.
- b. This policy is important because it is a requirement of the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) that there be sufficient patients, cases and procedures for resident education. Addition of other learners who are not residents of that program may cause the resident education to be diminished. Compliance with this ACGME requirement is necessary for continued institutional and program accreditation.

III. Process/Content

- a. The presence of other learners (including, but not limited to PA Fellow, residents from other specialties, subspecialty fellows, PhD students, and advanced practice nursing students) in the training program must not interfere with the education of the residents enrolled in the program.
- b. The presence of other learners during the current academic year must be reported in the program's Annual Report to the Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC),
