


# Using Zotero to access the HIDR Core eHealth/mHealth Technologies Toolkit Library

Zotero can be installed on your machine (see [installation instructions](#)) or run via the web at <https://www.zotero.org>.

## Joining the Group

Anyone with the **HIDR Core eHealth/mHealth Technologies Toolkit Library** [link](#) can view the library contents. However, to view and download attachments within the library, you must request access and join the group. To join the group, “Log In” to Zotero (see screenshot below) and then click the “Join” button. Once access has been granted, you will have full view access of the library.
