Sexual assault forensic examinations (SAFE) for survivors of sexual assault at any hospital in the state



Sexual Assault Exam via Telehealth (SAFE-T)

Facilities with an established SANE program (hubs) offer consultative SANE services via telehealth to facilities without 24/7 SANE coverage (satellites) in performing sexual assault forensic exams (SAFE) to survivors.

Consultations may include:

- Assisting staff with less experience in SAFEs through the exam process ensuring patientcentered, trauma-informed & evidence based care
- Acting as a mentor for SANEs in training
- Providing education to satellite staff on SAFE process, evidence collection and storage, traumainformed care and court testimony
- Acting as fact witnesses in court
